

Virtual or In-Person Interviews for the 2022-2023 Residency Recruitment Cycle?

POLL RESPONSES FROM CORD MEMBER RESIDENCY PROGRAMS September 2, 2022

The American Orthopaedic Association's CORD/Academics Committee leadership distributed a two-question poll to all CORD-member orthopaedic surgery residency programs on August 26, 2022.

• Of the 191 CORD program directors to whom the poll was sent, 41% responded.

Below is a summary of the results.





- The majority of programs that indicated they are doing Virtual and In-Person Interviews commented that they are hosting virtual for rotators and in person interviews for non-rotators.
- Others commented that they were planning to host in-person interviews but were required by institutional GME to offer some virtual interviews.
