

David Laverty is a fellowship trained Orthopedic Trauma Surgeon and Assistant Professor at the University of Texas Austin Dell Medical School. He graduated from the University of Iowa with a B.S. in Microbiology, and obtained his MD from the University of Iowa in 1998. After finishing fellowship in Akron, OH, he completed a fellowship in Orthopedic Trauma at Wake Forest University. He began his career in Austin in 2004, working in private practice with academic affiliations, and then became fully involved in the development of an orthopedic residency program at Dell Medical School in 2016.

Since that time, his clinical practice has focused on acute and reconstructive orthopedic trauma. Professionally, he has developed the Orthopedic trauma service that trains the medical students and residents at UT Dell Med. He has also served as Chief of Staff at Dell Medical Center at the University of Texas, and has been elected President of the medical staff for Ascension Texas.

He has continued to pursue research opportunities at Dell Med, with numerous publications and current work on NIH supported projects.
