

Dr. Christopher Lee is an Associate Professor of Orthopaedic Trauma, Associate Program Director, and Director of Quality and Safety for the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA. He graduated cum laude from the University of Notre Dame and received Alpha Omega Alpha honors from the Keck School of medicine at USC.
